## **President Report:**

Last week SP attended the president's meeting. Carter said SCOE is taking over SR City Schools. Met with Decker, 95% of it was about SPED. SP was blamed for most of the problems. The way people do their jobs is drastically changing. Employees were released, Hardie highlighted contractual violations, Decker is open to revisions. Note- if you are hired, CBA should not be violated by the job description. Case managers need to be clear on what they are doing. Should be in the school board packet. Decker said case managers should be doing the testing to id students for services. The first negotiation meeting was about the calendar. No one asked for anything yet. We shaved off some PD days, not sure what the response will be from the district. Union is going to ask a lot about safety - there are concerns. Benefits + salary: there is more money that they said they had. They are open about this. Board meeting tonight. A lot of negative reporting in PD.. not sure if a lot of parents are going to show up. Last meeting, SP feels the speaking got out of hand at our meeting, she states she should have said, 'order, order.'

# Site Concerns (2 minute time limits):

**MWE-** SPED thing. Patricia emailed. We are unsure of what is going on. They are moving people around, it's all confusing. No one knows what's going on...kinda crazy. Communication piece is missing. Berardi was asked to sign something by Pete, she said she was not comfortable signing anything. He put in that she was not losing job, etc, two weeks later he decided she was moving to a new position, they ripped it up. They are offering positions to people that have not been advertised as vacant.

**BES-** We have to cut/alter 140K spending next year, we are cutting the Dean of Students. Can we consider asking the DO to cut a position at their site, rather than at our site? Alison

Griggs's position is officially no more. Annette is there to support the elementary school teachers. Can we get SPED students on gen ed rosters at the start of the year? Yes: ask the principal to put them on. Last, PLT meetings happen because the Dean holds students. Now that there's not Dean, what will happen with PLT?

**CCLA-** Ongoing concern over SPED.. RSP teacher is asked to jump in on all the classes her kids are in.. ineffective.. Big concern is that students are asked to do things in class that they cannot do, with not enough support. PD Google Form felt like 'we are mainstreaming SPED students even more, so here comes some training.'

**WMS-** We are unclear about what the WED meeting schedule is. No one is sure. Two admin, one dept/grade level, one work session, 5th is an additional work session or topic determined by the 'committee.' Feel free to speak up. Trading dates around after the schedule is set is not recommended.

**WHS-** Questions about cuts in other districts, high caseloads for counselors, bell schedule. The district does not feel they should compensate us more for a longer work day. Hardie is miffed about how a student fight was handled. Multiple girls are not being disciplined. They are still talking about 'kicking someone's ass." Hardie emailed the principal, no response. Why is there a student still on campus that pushed a teacher? Williams said the defense wasn't enough.

- 5. WDEA Scholarships- 2 applicants, will send out another email reminder
- 6. Staff members' dogs at worksites- members are all over the place with opinions. Dogs are not allowed at work sites during the school day.
